Universities Competition 13th July 2010

Overview of the competition

- The competition will be open to 16 teams.
- Group will be draw at random (there will be no seeding).
- The must be made up of students registered at that HE institution in the academic year 2009/10.
- Each team will be guaranteed a minimum of 4 games.

Primary Schools Festival – Tuesday 13th July 2010

There will be a two pronged approach to this day as follows:

- (i) A mixed POP competition will take place for schools who currently take part/have experience of competitive Lacrosse.
- (ii) At the same time there will be 'participation' event that will combine coaching and fun based competition.

The age groups will be Y5/6. Each school that takes part will adopt a country and will hopefully be provided with branded kit. Teams will also been given support on the day from players from that nation. By doing this it is hoped that it will spark off plenty of cross curricular activity.

Secondary Schools Festival – Wednesday 14th July 2010

There will be a two pronged approach to this day as follows:

- (i) A Boys & Girls Field Lacrosse Competition will take place for schools who currently take part/have experience of competitive Field Lacrosse.
- (ii) At the same time there will be 'participation' event that will combine coaching and fun based competition. This will be POP Lacrosse using Field Sticks.

Again, each school will adopt a Country and the selection process will be the same. No qualifying competition is therefore needed. The age groups is still to be confirmed, but very likely to be U14.
